

Opening Reception: October 15 & 16, 2022 Town Hall

What's the Art Show-Off: The Art Show-Off has been a very popular feature of Goffstown Main Street's Giant Pumpkin Weekend for over a decade. It is a very special exhibit celebrating the creativity of Goffstown area students from Pre-Schoolers through High School Seniors!

A special opening reception takes place during Pumpkin Regatta weekend, while the exhibit remains on display in Town Hall until the first week of December. During the reception, Art Show-Off guests are invited to vote for their favorite pieces. Over the next few days, the ballots are tallied up and ribbons are awarded to the top three recipients in the four age categories (preschool-K, G1-4, G5-8, G9-12). The ribbon recipients are invited to have their picture taken in town hall with their ribbon, next to their piece, which will be shared on social media (pending parental or guardian permission).

A few rules and guidelines:

- Students must attend Goffstown schools (public or private), or are homeschooled in Goffstown. (New Boston students attending Goffstown schools may enter.)
- Group/Class pieces are welcome. (We get delightful pieces from local Preschools through Kindergartens. But any art class collaborative work (i.e. a single large piece by the class would be great too.)
- One piece of artwork limit per student! (Multiple pieces do NOT increase chances for winning.)
- All artwork must be hangable or able to be affixed to the walls (drawings, paintings, photos, digital art and all forms of 2 dimensional art are acceptable).
- The affixed form must be completed and accompany the artwork. Pieces will be collected at the schools during the week of October 3-7, or are to be dropped off at the GMSP office that week (4 Main Street #2, Goffstown) by appointment, between 10-2. - It is highly recommended that pieces are either framed, matted or mounted on sturdy card stock or mat board to protect the work.
